We have noticed an increase in the number of open gates in Montague Gardens after working hours and over weekends. Here are some safety tips to protect your property and business.

- Make sure you take note if you are the last person to leave the office, to close the gate.
- Don't drive away while the gate is busy closing, wait just those extra 20 seconds for the gate to close completely behind you. Only then drive away.
- Take note of your neighbours' gates and check if their gates don't open when you push the button of your gate clicker.
- Make sure you have an emergency contact name and number outside of your business so that the MMID Star Alarm Patrollers can contact you if the gate is found open.
- Ensure your site perimeter has sufficient lighting
- Avoid lone worker lock-up
- If working with a skeleton staff, make sure you know who
 is coming in and out
- If closing completely, establish a locking-up procedure, to ensure nothing is forgotten.




URBAN & ENVIRONMENTAL UPGRADING


